[REDACTED] CRYSTAL, MINNESOTA, POLICE DEPARTMENT, FURNISHED FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

[REDACTED] HAS BEEN WITH CRYSTAL POLICE DEPARTMENT SINCE NINETEEN FIFTY ONE AND ACQUAINTED WITH DAHLBERG SINCE ABOUT THAT TIME. AFTER REVIEW OF HIS RECORDS, HE RECALLED HIS ARREST OF DAHLBERG, EVENING, AUGUST FOURTEEN, NINETEEN FIFTY THREE, WHEN DAHLBERG CHARGED WITH CARELESS DRIVING AND DRIVING WITHOUT LICENSE IN POSSESSION. AT THAT TIME HE, [REDACTED] WAS A PATROLMAN. ACCORDING TO [REDACTED] THIS ARREST WAS FOLLOWING A SERIOUS AUTO ACCIDENT, HIGHWAY ONE HUNDRED AND THIRTY FOURTH AVENUE NORTH, CRYSTAL, MINNESOTA, INVOLVING FOUR TEENAGE BOYS WHO WERE OCCUPANTS OF SMALL STATIONWAGON WHICH WAS STRUCK FROM REAR BY DAHLBERG. AS A RESULT, FOUR TEENAGERS SUBSEQUENTLY DIED.

[REDACTED] SAID SEVERAL PERSONS APPROACHED HIM AT SCENE OF ACCIDENT STATING DAHLBERG "WAS TRAVELING AT HIGH RATE OF SPEED" AND "DRIVING IN CARLESS MANNER". [REDACTED] RECALLS AFTER OBSERVING DAHLBERG, HE WAS CONVINCED DAHLBERG WAS UNDER INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL AT TIME OF ACCIDENT. DAHLBERG AGREED TO BLOOD TESTS TO DETERMINE AL<sup>C</sup>SOHOL CONTENT; HOWEVER, SUBSEQUENTLY
