REFUSED TO PARTICIPATE IN TEST FOR ALCOHOL. CONTENT. DAHLBERG ISSUED TICKET AT SCENE OF ACCIDENT FOR CARELESS DRIVING AND DRIVING WITHOUT LICENSE IN POSSESSION. ACCORDING TO [REDACTED] THERE WAS CONSIDERABLE ILL FEELING IN AREA BECAUSE OF CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING ACCIDENT, AND THEREFOR, HE AND OTHER POLICE OFFICERS INSISTED HENNEPIN COUNTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY CHARGE DAHLBERG WITH CRIMINAL NEGLIGENCE IN CONNECTION WITH DEATH OF FOUR YOUNG MEN AND PRESENT MATTER TO GRAND JURY. CASE PRESENTED TO GRAND JURY, HENNEPIN COUNTY, AND "NO BILL" RETURNED.

[REDACTED] SAID HE WAS NEVER SATISFIED WITH RESULTS IN THIS MATTER BECAUSE HE, EVEN THOUGH ON SCENE OF ACCIDENT ALMOST IMMEDIATELY, WAS NOT CALLED AS WITNESS. [REDACTED] DESCRIBED INVESTIGATION OF THIS ACCIDENT AND RESULTING DISPOSITION ONE OF MOST FRUSTRATING EVENTS OF CAREER, AS ACCIDENT MOST SERIOUS HE HAS OBSERVED TO TAKE PLACE AND HE STILL FEELS DAHLBERG WAS AT FAULT IN CAUSING DEATHS OF FOUR MEN FOR WHICH HE WAS NEVER HELD ACCOUNTABLE. [REDACTED] REVIEWED RECORDS AND DETERMINED DAHLBERG ON SEPT. ELEVEN, NINETEEN FIFTY THREE, APPEARED JUSTICE OF PEACE COURT, ENTERED GUILTY PLEA TO CHARGES OF CARELESS

DRIVING AND NO DRIVER'S LICENSE IN POSSESSION, FOR WHICH FINES WERE MAXIMUM ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS FIRST CHARGE AND MAXIMUM TEN DOLLARS ON SECOND CHARGE. FINES PAID SAME DATE.

[REDACTED] DETECTIVE DIVISION, CRYSTAL, MINNESOTA, POLICE DEPARTMENT, ADVISED HE WAS BOTH JUSTICE OF THE PEACE AND MEMBER OF CRYSTAL, MINNESOTA, FIRE DEPARTMENT, AUGUST FOURTEEN, NINETEEN FIFTY THREE, WHEN ABOVE -MENTIONED ACCIDENT OCCURRED IN THAT CITY. SAID HE WAS ONE OF FIRST WITNESSES ON SCENE AND FURNISHED SUBSTANTIALLY SAME INFORMATION AS [REDACTED] SAID HE WAS LISTED AS A WITNESS FOR GRAND JURY REGARDING ADDIDENT; HOWEVER, NEVER CALLED, AND WAS TOLD "WE NOW HAVE ALL THE WITNESS NECESSARY." [REDACTED] SAID TO INDIVIDUALS WHOM EH CANNOT IDENTIFY CONTACTED HIM JUST PRIOR TO SEPT. ELEVEN, NINETEEN FIFTY THREE, AS REPRESENTATIVES FOR MR. DAHLBERG REGARDING THE CARELESS DRIVING CHARGE AND DRIVING WITHOUT A LICENSE IN HIS POSSESSION, WHICH WAS SCHEDULED FOR HIS COURT. HE SAID THEY ATTEMPTED TO INFLUENCE HIM TO DROP THESE CHARGES; HOWEVER, HE REFUSED TO DO SO AND SUGGESTED A CHANGE OF VENUE. [REDACTED] SAID DAHLBERG SUBSEQUENTLY PLED GUILTY
