[REDACTED] DETECTIVE DIVISION, CRYSTAL, MINNESOTA, POLICE DEPARTMENT, ADVISED HE WAS BOTH JUSTICE OF THE PEACE AND MEMBER OF CRYSTAL, MINNESOTA, FIRE DEPARTMENT, AUGUST FOURTEEN, NINETEEN FIFTY THREE, WHEN ABOVE -MENTIONED ACCIDENT OCCURRED IN THAT CITY. SAID HE WAS ONE OF FIRST WITNESSES ON SCENE AND FURNISHED SUBSTANTIALLY SAME INFORMATION AS [REDACTED] SAID HE WAS LISTED AS A WITNESS FOR GRAND JURY REGARDING ADDIDENT; HOWEVER, NEVER CALLED, AND WAS TOLD "WE NOW HAVE ALL THE WITNESS NECESSARY." [REDACTED] SAID TO INDIVIDUALS WHOM EH CANNOT IDENTIFY CONTACTED HIM JUST PRIOR TO SEPT. ELEVEN, NINETEEN FIFTY THREE, AS REPRESENTATIVES FOR MR. DAHLBERG REGARDING THE CARELESS DRIVING CHARGE AND DRIVING WITHOUT A LICENSE IN HIS POSSESSION, WHICH WAS SCHEDULED FOR HIS COURT. HE SAID THEY ATTEMPTED TO INFLUENCE HIM TO DROP THESE CHARGES; HOWEVER, HE REFUSED TO DO SO AND SUGGESTED A CHANGE OF VENUE. [REDACTED] SAID DAHLBERG SUBSEQUENTLY PLED GUILTY

RECORDS OF HENNEPIN COUNTY, MINNESOTA, COUNTY ATTORNEY'S OFFICE REFLECT HENNEPIN COUNTY GRAND JURY RETURNED ON SEPT. THREE, NINETEEN FIFTY THREE, A "NO BILL" IN REGARD TO INDICTMENT OF CRIMINAL NEGLIGENCE ON AUGUST FOURTEEN, NINETEEN FIFTY THREE IN REGARDS TO THE ABOVE-MENTIONED ACCIDENT.
