HE HAD FOREIGN SERVICE IN EUROPEAN THEATER OF OPERATIONS AND WAS AWARDED THE EUROPEAN AFRICAN MIDDLE EASTERN MEDAL WITH SIX BATTLE STARS, THE AIR MEDAL WITH FIFTEEN OAK LEAF CLUSTERS, THE PURPLE HEART MEDAL WITH ONE OAK LEAF CLUSTER, THE SILVER STAR MEDAL, THE DISTINGUISHED FLYING CROSS WITH ONE OAK LEAF CLUSTER, THE DISTINGUISHED SERVICE CROSS, THE DISTINGUISHED CITATION, AND THE WORLD WAR TWO VICTORY MEDAL.

HIS CHARACTER AND EFFICIENCY RATINGS RANGED FROM SATISFACTORY TO EXCELLENT AND THERE WAS NO RECORD OF COURTS MARTIAL OR AWOL.

RECORDS INDICATED HE WAS MISSING IN ACTION AND A PRISONER OF WAR FROM FEBRUARY FOURTEEN, FORTYFIVE TO APRIL TWENTYNINE, FORTYFIVE.

RECORDS INDICATED THAT DISCIPLINARY PUNISHMENT WAS IMPOSED ON DAHLBERG ON NOVEMBER FIFTEEN, FORTYFOUR BY THE COMMANDING
