Thanks for getting back so quickly. Had a couple of other things, dating back to our phone conversation, that I also wanted to make sure I understood. Here they are:

- Almost all applications being filed under the new state program are being filed by individuals, and not attorneys.
- Regarding the spread sheet your office sent: A black line indicates that an expungement has been granted -- and the black line may mean a person had more than one case expunged.
- An application is reviewed by either a county or city attorney and, if they agree, the application for expungement is filed with a district court. Very few -- if any -- applications have been turned down by district courts since the program began last year.
