Thanks again for participating. Just a couple of quick notes from today's discussion:

1. Based on input from folks on the call, it seems the targeted visa "ban" that [SCOTUS decided 5-4 not to invalidate](#) has been having both an actual, direct impact on certain prospective students from subject countries, and also an indirect, caution-producing effect on potential students who, strictly speaking, fall outside of the restricted categories.
2. OVPR/SPA/CSE have a good handle on the (relatively minimal) research relationship with Huawei. Pamela and I will continue monitoring the pulse of our counterparts' approaches to Huawei and ZTE; if anyone else learns of any developments in this area from peers, please don't hesitate to pass the information along.
