Caller: Oh no, no, no I called around 2:00 when I was in the middle of the protest.

Operator: Okay.

Caller: I got like a video of it here. It was crazy, it's like I was in the middle of all the flames and like stuck, and I liked watched them and they like took a whole bunch vans, they're like street dragging and wanted to (inaudible) into a crowd and then took off.

Operator: Okay, alright I will um...are you currently like near Lake and Minnehaha or is that where you were when this happened?

Caller: Well, that's where I was, I left. It got too violent. There started it was like (inaudible) people like (inaudible) so I just left after I seen that.

Operator: Alright your name, sir?
