We were interested in a lawsuit that goes back to 2020, and involves a TV station in Rhinelander, WI (WJFW-TV) that was sued by the Trump campaign over the airing of a political ad put together by Priorities Action USA.

The lawsuit was dismissed, but we were interested in getting some information from you/the Trump campaign about its ad:

- How many stations across the country aired the ad during the 2020 campaign?
- How many lawsuits were filed against media outlets (TV stations) that aired the ad?
- If the WJFW-TV case was the only lawsuit, do you have any insight as to why the Trump campaign targeted that particular TV station?
